President's report and Treasurer's Report—We have spent 46% of our yearly budget and doing very well. The deposits for the month were \$238 from yard sale and \$5,000 from GVEA Good Sense Grant. A rent check for \$300 was sent for Frank's Place.

 - Clausen planter bed construction and topsoil fill. Rained out on three occasions. Will need pick up to haul topsoil when beds are ready.

We added an assortment of books donated by a friend of a board member, which included Alaskana, fiction, natural history and modern history, as well as a few from Ray Hadley's collection of science and philosophy. Five music books on bluegrass and old-time music were also cataloged and shelved. We plan to finish up some more classical music scores and the last boxes of young adult books in July. On June 25th we had two visitors to the library. This month's catalogers included Suzann Suzawith, Kay Sisson, Mo Musik and Mindy Gallagher
