Board of Directors May 15, 2022

The meeting was called to order via zoom at 3:36 by President Gary Pohl.

Agenda:

It was suggested that we add the moving of the conex and the discussion with Don Kiely about IT security under Old Business or simply under Gary's report. ST moved to accept the agenda, Mindy seconded and the motion passed.

Minutes:

A number of corrections were offered for the April minutes taken by Gary during Ritchie's absence. Gary corrected the minutes after the meeting, and the corrected minutes will be posted. Ritchie moved to approve the minutes, Mindy seconded and the minutes were approved as corrected.

President's Report:

Gary reported that the FSNB Community Revenue Sharing application for the next fiscal year FY23 has been submitted. He was happy that the building survived the winter with no damage from snow load or other mishap. There was nothing to report that was new. Ritchie pointed out that her husband noticed the downspout on the driveway emptied near the foundation and could undermine the foundation. Gary will check on it.

Financial report:

Yukon river paid the \$524 for the flowers for which they owed. The fire insurance for the library was paid. Phone charges will increase. It was suggested that fuel charges are also likely to increase. On this date \$750 of the \$800 budgeted for GEB has been spent leaving \$50 available. The plant sale will bring in income.

GEB

Plants have been maintained in the UAF greenhouse for the last two months. They will be moved to the library on April 27th for the plant sale on the 28th.

OLD BUSINESS

A planning session for the event will be held on Thursday May 26th from 4 to 5. Ritchie moved to budget \$250 for the event and Mindy seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Facebook Image

We received a letter saying that a bubble image on our Facebook page was copyrighted and we had no permission to use it. We are asked to remove it immediately and pay a fine of \$315. This came from a source called PicRights International and referred to an image No. AFP_VO65R. Ritchie took the photo from the internet from what she believed to be public domain. We are questioning if this is a scam or something to be concerned about. Ritchie will locate the source(s) from which the picture came. ST will forward the email to board members.

Future Board Recruitment

Mina and ST will both be leaving the area and will need to be replaced on the board. Our positions are formally up in October. Ritchie offered the possibility of moving her open hours to those of Mina's to help with the knitting group. She is not willing to add this onto her regular Thursday hours. Mindy suggested that the group could simply use the library as a member group and if folks came into check out books it would not be a problem. Gary is not willing to serve another year as President but will remain on the board, Ritchie is willing to take on Treasurer if ST will train her in Quickbooks. A new secretary will be needed.
